

He is by the famed multi-World Champion sire Sultan's Great Day, who sired such greats as WC Along Came A Spider, WC CH Great Day's Came The Son, Nahema, CH Great Day's Token and WC CH Simply Mahvalous, etc.

WCC Call Me Ringo's dam side reads like a "Who's Who." The electrifying Fine Harness World Champion Eleanor Rigby is the dam of this exceptional stallion. She was a winner at every major horse show and made her presence known every time she entered the ring. (She was sired by the Fine Harness World Grand Champion Buck Rogers). The second dam, Peregrine, also produced the winning fivegaited mare Heart's Miracle Miss. (Dam of 2005 American Royal fivegaited junior champion). Call Me Ringo's third dam was the beautiful three-gaited mare CH Heart To Heart by WC sire Starheart Stonewall. CH Heart To Heart was also the dam of Just Maggie, dam of WC Cats Don't Dance.

The highly successful World Champion sire My Magical Moment will stand the 2008 season at **Queenwood Stables LLC**. Danette owns this unique individual and she is eager to continue to breed, train,

My Magical Moment is by the famed Fine Harness World Grand Champion Sultan's Santana, who has sired multi-World Champions in every division. My Magical Moment is a full brother to World Champion Mystical Mood, RWC and stakes winner My Grande, American Royal fine harness champion My Magical Mood and Mystical Miss (dam of WC CH A Magic Spell). My Magical Moment's dam, My Flame (sired by Reserve World Grand Champion CH Kourageous Kalu), also produced major stakes winners, My Supreme Flame, What About Bob, RWC How Fortunate, etc. The second dam of My Magical Moment's pedigree is the great Five-Gaited World Champion CH Wing Flame. (WGC CH Wing Commander x High Point Flame BHF). WC CH Wing Flame is a half-sister to WC sire Starheart Victory and CH Highpoint Ace, Indiana Flame (dam of WC CH The King Of Highpoint), Society's Flame, second dam of WC S.S. Lies And Alibis, and third dam of WC CH A Touch Of Champagne and World Champion sire Flame Of Greystone. My Magical Moment's third dam, High Point Flame, is a Hall of Fame Broodmare!

My Magical Moment continues to produce champions in the performance and futurity divisions. In 2007, he was the sire of World Champion Junior Exhibitor Five-Gaited Stonecroft Rumor Has It. In 2006, he was the sire of World Champion Kentucky Amateur Weanling Futurity winner Delirium, and World Champion Kentucky Amateur Yearling Futurity winner Sayonara Belle. My Magical Moment is also the sire of the impressive three-gaited stakes winner Liberty's Magic, Reserve World Champion Fine Harness star You Move Me; Lexington's junior three-gaited stakes winner After Eight





(formerly Pinekrest Man In Black); junior exhibitor five-gaited champion Barnabas and Kentucky State Fair third place fine harness ribbon winner, Pinekrest Delta Force.

My Magical Moment has an incredible pedigree that traces to seven World Grand Champions and combinations of World Champion bloodlines in all three divisions, which includes the golden cross of Supreme Sultan and Wing Commander, and he has 16 Hall of Fame Broodmares in his five generations of pedigree.

World Champion Sire Only Man In Town #99869 (CH Man On The Town x Only You)

The big, handsome World Champion sire Only Man In Town continues to put show ring winners into the futurity and performance arenas. He is owned by Sunrise Stables and Danette Musselman and will again be breeding future stars for mare owners. Only Man In Town is sired by Five-Gaited World Grand Champion CH Only Man On The Town and is out of Only You by World Champion sire Supreme Sultan. Only You was a very successful five-gaited stakes winner throughout her career. Only Man In Town's sire is WGC CH Man On The Town, who has sired such noteworthy World Champions as 2006 Five-Gaited World Grand Champion He's The Man; WC Lace On The Town; WC City Lady; WC A Woman's Touch and 11 Reserve World Champion titleholders.

WC sire Only Man In Town is the sire of 2005 Junior Five-Gaited World Champion of Champions It's All About Me and World Champion Home Town Edition. In 2007, his offspring were making their names known throughout the country in the show rings, with national champions Rox No Salt in the five-gaited division at Charity Fair; Elegant Mandarin winning the park division at the Humanitarian's Challenge; Double Secret Probation TS winning in

the MGM Spring junior five-gaited division and in 2006 winning the Wisconsin Futurity three-year-old park division; and Man Of Liberty winning the Mid America Spring UPHA Fine Harness blue.

Only Dream In Town in 2006 won the two-year-old fine harness at Illinois State Fair, and went on to top three in the highly competitive two-year-old park sweepstakes. Royal Crest's Rock Island was the 2002 Wisconsin Futurity Breeders' Stake winner. O' Man Alive was the 2005 Illinois Yearling Open and Grand Champion.

Only Man In Town is an extremely large stallion (16.3 hands) that is passing bone and substance to his foals. He is extremely talented off both ends and with his impeccable bloodlines, only greatness is the destiny for this royally bred World Champion sire.

Perfect Cover #102083

(CH Caramac x Wing's Fashion Plate)

Dan Musselman is the owner of Perfect Cover, bred to a few select mares, and his offspring are starting to grace the show rings. **Queenwood Stables** will offer this stallion to the public. Perfect Cover is by World Grand Champion CH Caramac (who has sired such world champions as WC CH My Chanel; WC CH Carmen Miranda; WC CH Callaway's Arbitrator; WC Carmelita Santana, etc.) and he is out of the three-gaited show mare Wing's Fashion Plate by Wing's Desirable, who brings in the blood of Wing's Fleet Admiral. Wing's Fashion Plate also produced the winning three-gaited horse Red Hook. Perfect Color has a pedigree that brings in World Grand Champion CH Wing Commander on the top and bottom sides! Perfect Cover's second dam is Doubletrees Fashion, who also produced CH Wing's Fashion.

Perfect Cover was shown to wins in the fine harness division with Dan Musselman at the lines throughout the West Coast. Perfect Cover is the sire of the multi-champion junior exhibitor five-gaited champion Covered In Sable. Covergirl Sweetheart was a three-year-old fine harness champion and is now a three-gaited pleasure champion in the Northeast.

The offspring of Perfect Cover are very high headed, with no shortness of "go forward." Most of his prospects have the natural talent to rack up a storm, and have the stamina to go on and on, with good minds and ability. If you are looking for a future five-gaited prospect, please consider breeding to this stallion.




Rifles And Roses #94782

train, show, and sell," Danette said. Throughout the years, Rifles And Roses has remained a popular stallion for many reasons. He has sired numerous show ring winners; amateur and juvenile horses, futurity champions, and of course, World Champions.

Bred at Double Dove Farm at Versailles, Kentucky, Danette and Rifles And Roses have been together ever since. This stallion comes from a family of World Champion bloodlines. His sire was the black, multi-World Champion sire Carey's Night Of Love, who boasts the Society Rex, Bourbon Genius, and Stonewall's Golden Dream bloodlines.

His dam, World Champion producer Symbol Song, had a strong pedigree that shows two crosses to Private Contract, full brother to WGC Wing Commander, highlighting her lineage.

Rifles And Roses is a full brother to WC CH Love Them Roses, WC Night Of Roses, and WC producer Night Of Love Song. Rifles And Roses is the sire of World Champion Pistolero, World Champion Sophie Simpson, World Champion High Powered Rifle, RWC DeGuello, and RWC My Jose Cuervo. (DeGuello and My Jose Cuervo were each winners of the Bluegrass Yearling Futurity, winning significant prize monies.)

2007 brings into the winner's circle WC Pistolero winning national titles in the amateur three-gaited park division and top three at the World's Championships. Callaway's Shotgun racked his way to championship wins at the Carousel Show. Loaded Weapon proved again he could have the victory pass photo ... this time at Kentucky Spring Premiere. All Stirred Up is the stakes winning and ladies fivegaited champion. Lucky Son Of A Gun carried home blues in the fine harness division. Capturing the Roanoke ladies five-gaited title was Packin' A Pistol. Winning the Kentucky Spring Premier park pleasure driving blue was My Jose Cuervo. Futurity winners include the brilliant young star The Pistol winning the Missouri Weanling Breeders' Challenge and Illinois Futurity weanling championship; Pull The Trigger was crowned the Illinois Yearling Futurity Champion and Ruger Blackhawk won the Illinois Futurity weanling colt title.
